Union Park 125th Anniversary Celebration

Union Park is 125 years old! 2019 marks the 125th anniversary of Union Park and a celebration of this anniversary will take place on Saturday, September 28th. This anniversary celebration will coincide with the City of Des Moines Parks Department Fall Family Fun Fest; to create a full day of celebration and excitement inside of the park. On the day in which the park was inaugurated in 1896 there was a bicycle parade that ran from the East Village of downtown Des Moines to the park and in similar fashion that is how this 125th birthday celebration will start.

There will be a bicycle ride from Union Park to Peace Tree Brewing downtown and then back to Union Park via the bicycle trail, which will then culminate and end with a bicycle parade around the south loop of the park. Any children participating will have an opportunity to decorate their bicycles for this bicycle parade. We will then have a free hot dog feed and some opportunities to explore old maps and historical documents chronically the history of Union Park. A guided "History walk" will also take place around the park to discover some of the

historic areas and places that have been inside Union Park over the last 125 years.

The Fall Family fun fest will host a Trik-a-thon, food eating contests, inflatables, DJ, Face painter, Police and S.W.A.T Vehicle and K-9 Dog, and fire truck.



12:30-4pm - Historical documents and articles about Union Park in the Swanson Shelter



Over 1200 free rides on the Heritage Carousel (Sponsored by Mercy One Children’s Hospital) were given. Volunteers handed out 2211 cups of water and lemonade, 45 bottles of water and 56 bottles of Gatorade. They gave out 2500 bags of popcorn, 378 cups of yogurt, 2500 pieces of pizza and 180 granola bars. There were inflatables, Safety Street, 400 bike helmets were given away, free clown noses, music, games, juggling, dancers, stage entertainment and of course, clowns, clowns and more clowns.
