## SCRUB—Spring Cleanup to Reduce Urban Blight

**SCRUB** stands for SPRING CLEANUP to REDUCE URBAN BLIGHT. It is the City's mission to enhance the City's neighborhoods by allowing residents an opportunity to remove yard waste and debris from homes and yards to reduce the blighted areas within the City.

What kind of SCRUB events does the City of Des Moines sponsor? MEGA SCRUB: An event that is hosted by select neighborhoods within their section of the City. Any Des Moines Resident may participate. Transfer Station SCRUB: An alternate drop-off location used for SCRUB events. The Metro Waste Transfer Station is located at 4198 Delaware Ave.

Compost Site SCRUB: A drop off site designated for yard and tree debris during SCRUB events. The Des Moines Compost Site is located at 1601 Harriett Street.

**SCRUB Event Reminders Free Drop off - Delays Possible** 

Proof of Residency is required - Bring a photo id or current utility bill. Before each event, please review the <u>SCRUB guidelines</u>. MEGA SCRUB events now offer Household Hazardous Waste Disposal. <u>See list of items.</u> (MEGA SCRUB sites only) SCRUB events are free to Des Moines citizens, therefore you may experience longer wait times based on participation.

## The Greenleaf Center Nourishing Neighbors

Located at 1350 East Washington Avenue, The Greenleaf Center's mission is to cultivate a space for Des Moines parks area neighbors and friends to gather and grow. Everyone on the Greenleaf Center's board lives within a mile of the Whittier Building, and they know that now is the time to turn this space into an asset for our community.



Their vision is to be a hub for

growing produce and preparing food, for artists and musicians to create and share their art, for entrepreneurs to grow their businesses, and for neighbors to gather and connect. Here's how they plan to do that:

The rehabilitation of this historic school in Des Moines will preserve its historic character, embracing its history as a school and a community space. They will add ADA accessibility, improve the building's energy efficiency, and bring the grounds back to life as a vibrant gardening and gathering space.

### The School:

The former classrooms of the original 1875 historic wooden school, the 1904 brick expansion, and the 1950s addition will house a cafe, coworking space, and loft-style offices. Two spacious art studios will reside on the lower level.

## The Kitchen:

The Shared Use Commercial Kitchen will bring the Des Moines metro's vibrant and growing food scene right to our doorsteps. Designed for up-and-coming food entrepreneurs, the Greenleaf Center Kitchen will be a home base for a variety of licensed food businesses to expand, learn, and potentially collaborate together. (They are already dreaming of the culinary masterpieces that will be created in that kitchen.)

### The Garden:

Blessed with abundant sunshine, the garden will include an outdoor patio space with shaded seating area where friends and neighbors can gather for urban agriculture classes, social events, food truck pop-ups, performances, and more! Surrounded by beautiful food crops and flower gardens, this space will welcome everyone to stop in, spend some time in nature, and recharge.
