What is National Night Out

On Tuesday, August 5, 2025 residents of Des Moines are being invited to join millions of citizens and law enforcement agencies across the nation in supporting a unique crime and drug prevention event called "National Night Out". This is a long-time nationwide event and the City of Des Moines has participated for many years.

National Night Out is designed to heighten crime and drug prevention awareness; generate support for and participation in local anticrime programs: strengthen community spirit and police neighborhood cooperation; and most importantly, to send a message to criminals that neighborhoods are fighting back against crime.

Nationally, the National Association of Town Watch (www.natw.org) sponsors this event. In Des Moines, the Des Moines Police Department as well as the various Neighborhood Associations and local businesses sponsor and support these activities.

Residents are asked to turn on their porch lights, as well as get outside and enjoy their neighborhood.

Several activities are planned throughout Des Moines. We will be celebrating the greatest resource of Des Moines – its neighborhoods. We hope you will join us at the neighborhood events. Many groups in Des Moines are hosting activities for their neighbors and members. A variety of special events including cookouts, games, block parties, and ice cream socials are scheduled.

The Des Moines Police Neighborhood Based Delivery Team explains that national Night Out is an extension of our community policing efforts. SCRUB—Spring Cleanup to Reduce Urban Blight

SCRUB stands for SPRING CLEANUP to REDUCE URBAN BLIGHT. It is the City's mission to enhance the City's neighborhoods by allowing residents an opportunity to remove yard waste and debris from homes and yards to reduce the blighted areas within the City.

What kind of SCRUB events does the City of Des Moines sponsor?

MEGA SCRUB: An event that is hosted by select neighborhoods within their section of the City. Any Des Moines Resident may participate.

Transfer Station SCRUB: An alternate drop-off location used for SCRUB events. The Metro Waste Transfer Station is located at 4198 Delaware Ave.

Compost Site SCRUB: A drop off site designated for yard and tree debris during SCRUB events. The Des Moines Compost Site is located at 1601 Harriett Street.

SCRUB Event Reminders Free Drop off - Delays Possible

Proof of Residency is required - Bring a photo id or current utility bill.

Before each event, please review the SCRUB guidelines.

MEGA SCRUB events now offer Household Hazardous Waste Disposal. (MEGA SCRUB sites only) SCRUB events are free to Des Moines citizens, therefore you may experience longer wait times based on participation.






